The Practice of Encaustic & Its Application: January 22-24

Taught by Michael David and Thomas Swanston, this workshop provides participants with an immersive experience from the classical use of the medium to the highly experimental. It is tailored to the individual who wishes to deepen their creative self-expression through the practice of encaustic.

Intermediate Drawing: Thursdays, 7 - 9:30 pm beginning January 14

Taught by Michael David and Thomas Swanston, this hands on studio experience is designed for those with some experience drawing who wish to deepen their creative expression and have fun doing it. Cost is \$350 (including model fee) for 8 sessions

Narrative Painting: Saturdays 1 - 3:30 pm beginning January 30

Taught by Michael David, Tom Swanston, and Gail Foster. In this class we will explore narrative through the use of a variety of tools, both traditional and non-traditional. You will become familiar with the principles of painting such as line, tone, mass, light, composition, positive/negative space, scale, subject matter and both analytical and emotional observation. We will do all of this in a supportive atmosphere. Discussion of studio work will be an ongoing group activity with the goal being that when you complete the course you will be excited about Narrative and with a sense of direction in the development of your art work for the future. Cost is \$345 for 8 week session (includes model fees and some materials)

Social Media for Artists: February 5-7

This workshop, led by James Harris, will bridge the intersection of social media and the new world of art marketing. It will explore all facets of modern social media, including 21st Century connectivity to private collectors, institutional curators and a new network of support that every artist needs to be successful. 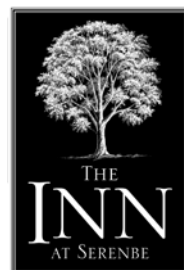
